

Royal Australian Navy Band will join Yorke Peninsula's Saltwater Classic

The Royal Australian Navy Band will be a headline act in the entertainment package at Yorke Peninsula's Saltwater Classic in Stansbury and Port Vincent on the weekend of 9 and 10 April.

Bandmaster Kara Williams said visitors to the event in the sister towns would enjoy some of the band's most popular jazz and rock music.

The band will perform on the foreshore in Stansbury from 11.30am to about 2.30pm on Saturday 9 April and from 10.00am to noon in Port Vincent the following day.

"Our talented musicians promote awareness of the Navy's critical contribution to the nation, and we look forward to bringing our unique brand of music to add to the excitement of Yorke Peninsula's Saltwater Classic," Kara said.
